Claudia Jennings has been the artistic director of the Windsbach Girls' Choir since 2025. She studied choral and orchestral conducting in Brazil, where she also successfully completed her master's degree in choral symphonic music. In Germany, she completed a master's degree in children's and youth choir conducting at the University of Music, Theatre and Media in Hanover.

Claudia Jennings has participated in various projects. Among other things, she was a choral conductor and educational advisor for 'Sing', a project of the Rundfunkchor Berlin, initiated the Leo Borchard Choir School and has conducted several choirs. She is a lecturer at training courses, seminars, choir meetings and courses and has worked with the Brandenburg State Music Council, the Rundfunkchor Berlin and music colleges and universities, among others.

In 2014, Claudia Jennings won 1st prize at the German Choir Competition in Weimar with the preliminary choir of the Hanover Girls' Choir. She is currently also in demand as a juror for choral competitions. Since 2016, Claudia Jennings has been the musical director of the Brandenburg State Youth Choir, with which she regularly performs in Brandenburg, Berlin and abroad. She has also been a lecturer in choral and orchestral conducting at the Evangelische Hochschule für Kirchenmusik Halle an der Saale since 2022. Concert tours and courses have taken her to China, Vietnam, South Africa, France, Brazil and South Korea, among others.

In March 2025, she began setting up the Windsbach Girls' Choir, has already organised the first auditions with girls and is the contact person for interested families. In September 2025, she will start rehearsals with the Windsbach Girls' Choir.
